

# INTERNATIONAL ATTENDEES

The C2U Expo attracts a considerable number of attendees and guest speakers from around the world. International attendees can participate at the Expo; however, each international attendee should individually confirm if a visa is required for entry to Canada prior to registering.

Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada provides a list of countries for which visa restrictions apply, as well as all other pertinent information attendees may require before making any travel plans. International attendees should give themselves plenty of time as the entire application process can take several months. Note that visa-exempt foreign nationals (excluding U.S. citizens) must still acquire the new Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA). This can be done online via the Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada website.

The registration confirmation email, which all attendees receive from the C2U Expo, is automatically generated and does not represent an invitation to attend the C2U Expo for visa purposes. If you are presenting at the conference a letter of invitation can be provided by the Program Committee if needed. Please contact [c2uexpo2020@algonau.ca](mailto:c2uexpo2020@algonau.ca) to request one. International attendees must understand that an invitation letter does not guarantee a visa, and must be prepared to provide documents as requested by their respective Canadian Consulates.
